Job Faced Crisis

•He was in the hands of Satan.
•Job did not realize that there are heavenly matters with God he knew nothing about yet deeply affected his life.

•He was in the hands of men.
•Job's best comfort wasn't receiving explanations for his suffering. He needed assurances of God's presence.

Job's Four Friends

1. Eliphaz (4:1-7, 17; 5:17)
• Rationalist who reasoned with Job

2. Bildad (8:3, 4, 6)
• Apologist who sought to defend God

3. Zophar (11:1, 4, 5, 7, 11, 14)
• Attorney who set up case against Job

4. Elihu (32:1-6; 33:12-13; 35:16)
• The youngest counselor

•He was in the hands of God.
•Job was changed when he moved from hearing practically to seeing God personally.




