Assurance of Salvation

"Being confident of this very thing, that he which hath begun a good work in you will perform it until the day of Jesus Christ." (Philippians 1:6)

Introduction:

The first elementary part of knowing God's will is knowing for sure that if you die today you will go to heaven. God's will for you is your <u>Sanctification</u> (I Thessalonians 4:3a).

Can you really know for sure that you are going to Heaven? Absolutely. 1 John 5:13 "These things have I written unto you that believe on the name of the Son of God; that ye may know that ye have eternal life, and that ye may believe on the name of the Son of God." Here are 7 of the most common reasons that a person doubts their salvation.

7 reasons why people doubt their salvation

- 1. Uncertainty about childhood Decisions (I John 5; John 3:36; Matthew 18:3; II Timothy 3:15).
- 2. Unconfessed sin (Psalm 51:10-12; 66:18; Proverbs 28:13).
- 3. Unconquered Life patterns (II Peter 2:10; I John 3:3; Jude 8).
- 4. Unrest from past Failures (Philippians 3:13-14; II Peter 1:10; I John 1:9).
- 5. Unresolved Conflicts (Psalm 66:18; Matthew 18:35; Hebrews 12:15).
- 6. Unfaithfulness in <u>Adding</u> to their faith (Ephesians 4:14-15; Hebrews 5:13-14; II Peter 1:5).
- 7. Unsaved (Matthew 18:12-14; Luke 13:3; II Corinthians 13:5).

Timothy, as a young man, was very Insecure, weak and ashamed of the Gospel. Paul encouraged him to be secure in Christ. 2 Timothy 1:12-13 – "For the which cause I also suffer these things: nevertheless I am not ashamed: for I know whom I have believed, and am persuaded that he is able to keep that which I have committed unto him against that day. Hold fast the form of sound words, which thou hast heard of me, in faith and love which is in Christ Jesus."

4 Action Points

- 1. Review your own Salvation experience (2 Peter 1:12).
- 2. <u>Identify</u> why you might doubt your salvation (2 Peter 2:9).
- 3. Hold fast to the sound Words of God (2 Timothy 1:12-13).
- 4. Trust God to Continue what He started (Philippians 1:6).
